About the Foundation





The LAST program is a collaborative effort between the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, and the National Fallen Firefighters Foundation. To best assist families and departments who had lost a firefighter in the line of duty, these agencies realized that they needed to have trained personnel on the ground and available to help when requested within six hours of death.
